

CHECKLIST FOR OWNER/AGENT

The following requirements must be met prior to testing

- Premises to be closed up **at least 24 hours before testing**
- Remove all contents that may affect air quality (e.g. incense, fuels, petrol powered tools)
- Firmly close all windows and doors and board up any broken doors and windows
- All dogs to be removed on the day of testing
- Septic tank and drainage field locations to be provided to FISL (if waste disposal concerns)
- Copies of paperwork from council/police/other testing agencies to be forwarded to FISL
- No non-FISL personnel to enter the premises during testing

Which remediation goal would you like to achieve for methamphetamine on surfaces

- 0.5 µg/100cm² (NZL Ministry of Health remediation guideline, accepted by Councils)
